Quick Facts for receptionists and people making referrals

What is Homeless Prevention and Rapid Rehousing Program (HPRP)

Two components of the HPRP program:

- 1.) Homeless Prevention
 - Keep individuals and families at immediate risk of becoming homeless in rental housing
- 2.) Rapid Re-Housing
 - Assist individuals & households who are literally homeless or in shelter for less than 90 days to obtain rental housing

HPRP is a needs-based program. DEPENDING ON ELIGIBILITY, HPRP MIGHT BE ABLE TO HELP WITH:

- Short-term rental assistance (No mortgage/ No subsidized housing/ No Section 8)
- Arrears
- Deposit (Rapid Re-Housing Component Only)

Initial Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Every household member must have a valid social security number
- ✓ Every household member must be a resident of Tulare County for the last 90 days
- ✓ Homeless Prevention Assistance may require household income to be 2 times the amount of rent
- ✓ Household must be able to provide documentation and verification of all information
- ✓ Low-income: Household income must be under 50% Area Median Income

- ❖ Additional eligibility requirements provided at Application & Orientation Workshop
- ❖ No re-entry into HPRP program accepted
- ❖ Participation in case management and financial education class required in HPRP program
- ❖ If household needs new move-in, client is responsible to find appropriate rental housing

HOW TO APPLY:

- Prospective clients must attend an Application & Orientation Workshop
- No late arrivals accepted at the workshops due to limited time and seating
- Prospective clients do not need to bring documentation to the Application & Orientation Workshop
